

## STEPS TO REOPENING YOUR FACILITY

As facilities in the DC metro area prepare for occupants returning to work, Mister Kleen is collaborating with our partners to ensure their facilities are safe for re-entry. As part of our Enhanced Kleen Program, Specialty Teams use EPA-registered disinfectants to combat the virus that causes COVID-19 and follow all guidelines for their use. They also wear appropriate PPE for the level of cleaning and disinfection they perform at each site.

## PHASE 1: TOTAL FACILITY DISINFECTION AND OTHER PREPARATIONS



- Specialty Teams use state-of-the-art Electrostatic Spraying technology that covers all sides of hard surfaces with disinfectant.
- Spray Disinfectant is used on soft surfaces such as carpets, rugs, drapes, and upholstered furniture.
- Mister Kleen works with clients to determine the amount of supplies needed, and can provide disposable disinfecting wipes as well as sanitizing stations.
- Clients are encouraged to place signage that promotes basic infection prevention measures throughout common areas.

## PHASE 2: ONGOING DISINFECTING IN HIGH TOUCH AND HIGH TRAFFIC AREAS



- Work and common areas will require more frequent cleaning and disinfection of high touch points.
- Fitness facilities and restaurants will need enhanced cleaning and disinfecting.
- Building teams will focus on high touch areas such as doors, lobbies, elevators, conference rooms, kitchens, restrooms escalators, furniture, trash cans, countertops, and more.
- Specialty Teams will remain poised to respond quickly if suspected or confirmed infection arises.
